Consent Statement

A list of the Terms and Conditions in operation at Minehead EYE is available at the centre, and on our website. In signing, I, the applicant or the parent or legal guardian of the applicant, state that **I have read, fully understood and agree that I/my child will abide by these Ts & Cs**

I understand that Minehead EYE is an unsupervised space and that members are free to come and go as they choose. In signing, **I consent that I/my child can attend and use the facilities at Minehead EYE without accompaniment or supervision** (so long as they are year 5 or over. (N.B. If you are not happy for your child to attend unaccompanied you should not give your consent for them to be a Member; instead they should become a Junior Member which means they will not be allowed in unless accompanied by a responsible adult.) I also understand that **anyone in year 4 or below will only be allowed to attend and/or take part in activities at Minehead EYE if he/she is accompanied by a responsible adult**. This adult must be at least 18 years of age. The management reserves the right to refuse entry if they do not consider any accompanying adult to be suitably responsible, for any reason whatsoever.

Skateboarding, BMX riding, inline roller-blading, scooting, climbing, trampolining and related activities can be hazardous activities, where the ability for accidents or injuries that may occur as a result of participation in any such activities at the centre. To reduce the risk of injury, helmets must be worn by all skatepark users under the age of 18, participating in any wheeled sports. We recommend knee, elbow and, where appropriate, wrist guards and mouth guards are also worn.

Participants in these activities should be aware of and accept these risks and be responsible for their own actions and involvement. In signing, I acknowledge the dangerous nature of skateboarding, inline roller-blading, BMX riding, scooting, climbing, bouldering, aerial yoga and related activities as may be undertaken at Minehead EYE.

Users of Minehead EYE are able access to the IT system and Internet from the IT suite. This usage is subject to acceptable use restrictions, as detailed in our Terms and Conditions. Minehead EYE will endeavour to take all reasonable steps to restrict access to unsuitable material on the Internet but ultimately users will be held responsible for their own actions.

In signing, I give **my consent that I/my child can use the IT system and internet at the EYE. It is my responsibility to inform Minehead EYE should I wish to revoke my consent at any time.**

So that we can deal as swiftly as possible with any injury or illness you must give consent for Minehead EYE to treat and/or authorise medical treatment for you/your child. In signing, **I give my consent for Minehead EYE to treat or authorise medical treatment for me/my child in the case of injury or illness.** By giving my consent I accept that I will not hold Minehead EYE liable for any acts, omissions or adverse results of any medical treatment administered.

All Members (year 5+) will be automatically made members of the Minehead EYE Community Interest Company (CIC) which is the body that runs Minehead EYE, unless they choose to opt out (see below). Being a member of the CIC means that you can have a say in the running of the centre, can attend and vote at the AGM and may even be able to stand to be on the Board of the organisation. In signing, **I give my consent that I/my child become a member of the Minehead EYE Community Interest Company (CIC)** (unless I choose to opt out below) (N.B. Not applicable to Guests).

From time to time, Minehead EYE may wish to film or photograph members on site and/or using the facilities. In signing I give my **consent that Minehead EYE may use and/or publish any photo/film in which I/my child appears** whilst at Minehead EYE or taking part in activities organised by Minehead EYE.

I consent to accept full responsibility for my actions/the actions of my child whilst using the skate park and bouldering cave at Minehead EYE or any of its facilities, including youth club activities and aerial yoga. I understand that I am giving my consent that I/my child use/s the facilities totally at my/their own risk and Minehead EYE is not liable in any way whatsoever for any injuries to myself/my child, to property or to third parties, that result from using or spectating at these facilities, whilst using equipment, skates, BMX, scooter or skateboard, except for in the case of negligence.

This applies also to any injuries which may be incurred from others. (N.B. Even if you don't intend to use the skate-park/bouldering cave itself, you must agree to the above to attend)

Activities that may be included in youth club sessions include all those available routinely at Minehead EYE, including in the skatepark itself (i.e. skateboarding, BMX riding, rollerblading, scooting etc.) music, IT. As well as sports, games, fundraising, barbeques, inter-club visits, arts and crafts and cooking.

Youth Club based workshops may deal with issues such as equality awareness, health and lifestyles, drugs and alcohol, relationships, sexuality and gender issues, independence, employment and career options. You will be informed of details of activities that take place outside the main vicinity of the unit's base or the EYE itself and be asked to give additional consent to young people participating in adventurous or non-routine off-site activities (EV5 Form). Please note that all the activities that take place within Minehead EYE are considered routine. Please let us know below if you do not consent for your child to take part in any particular activities, otherwise we will assume consent has been granted.

I do not consent for my child to take part in the following activities:

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Young people are expected to remain on the premises throughout a youth club session unless you have clearly relayed to staff that you require them to leave early. We cannot however force any young person to attend or remain at a session and cannot be responsible for the behaviour or welfare of anyone who chooses to leave the premises or session.

Please note that completion of this form DOES NOT bring with it full membership rights at Minehead EYE, but rather only activities undertaken there during organised youth club sessions. However, young people in year 5 upwards may also attend the EYE unaccompanied outside of the youth club sessions provided they have parental consent to do so.
